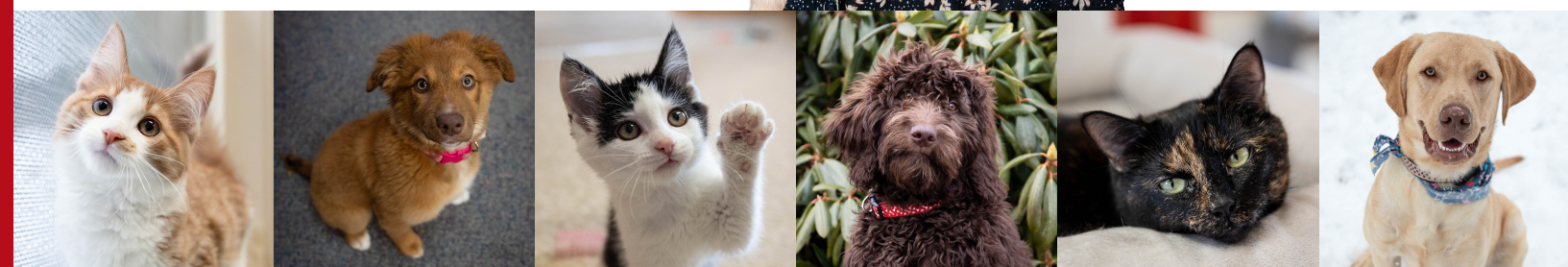
As we embrace the spirit of renewal that comes with spring, I invite you to consider ways in which you can further support our cause. Whether it's increasing your

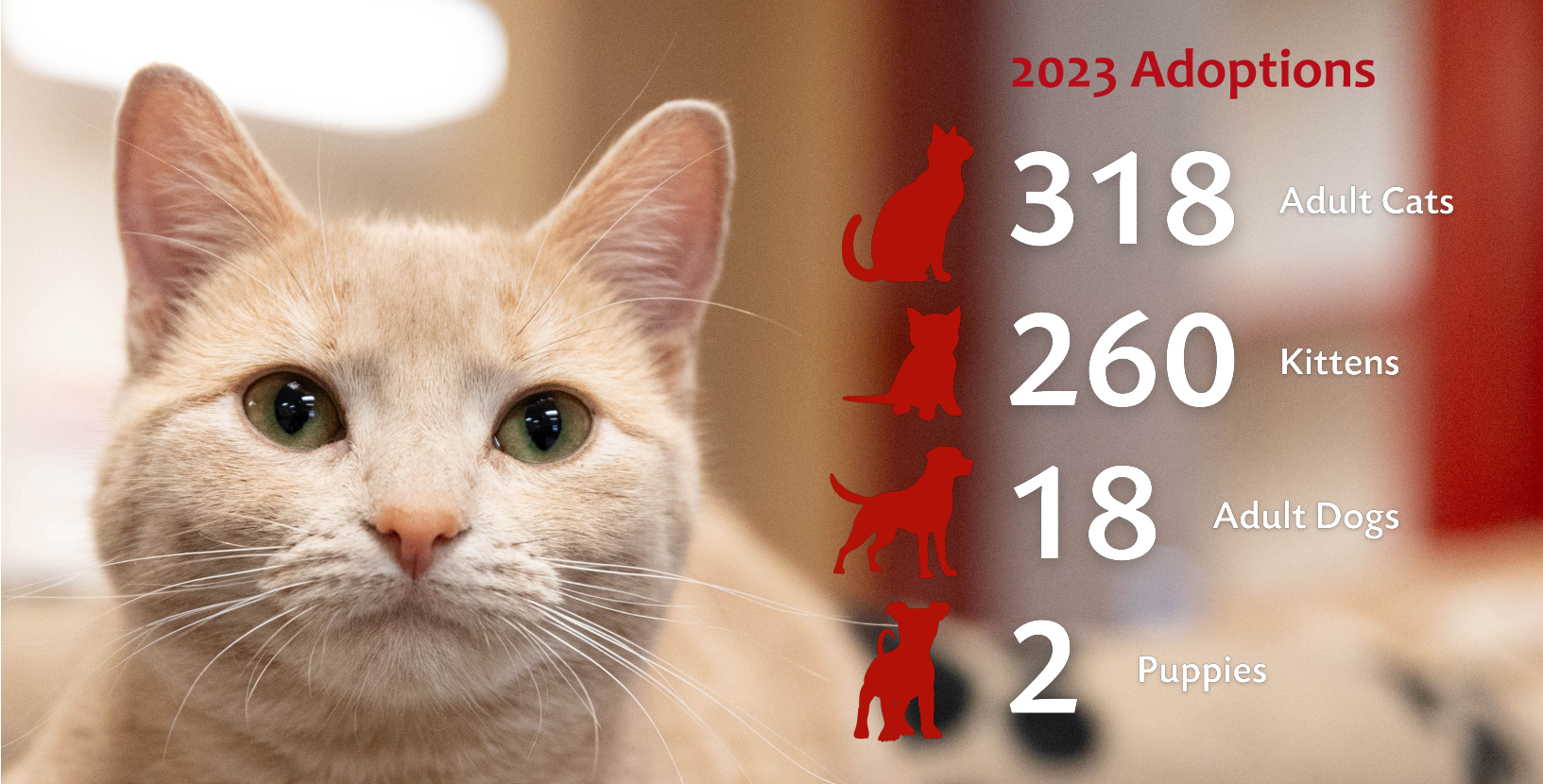
