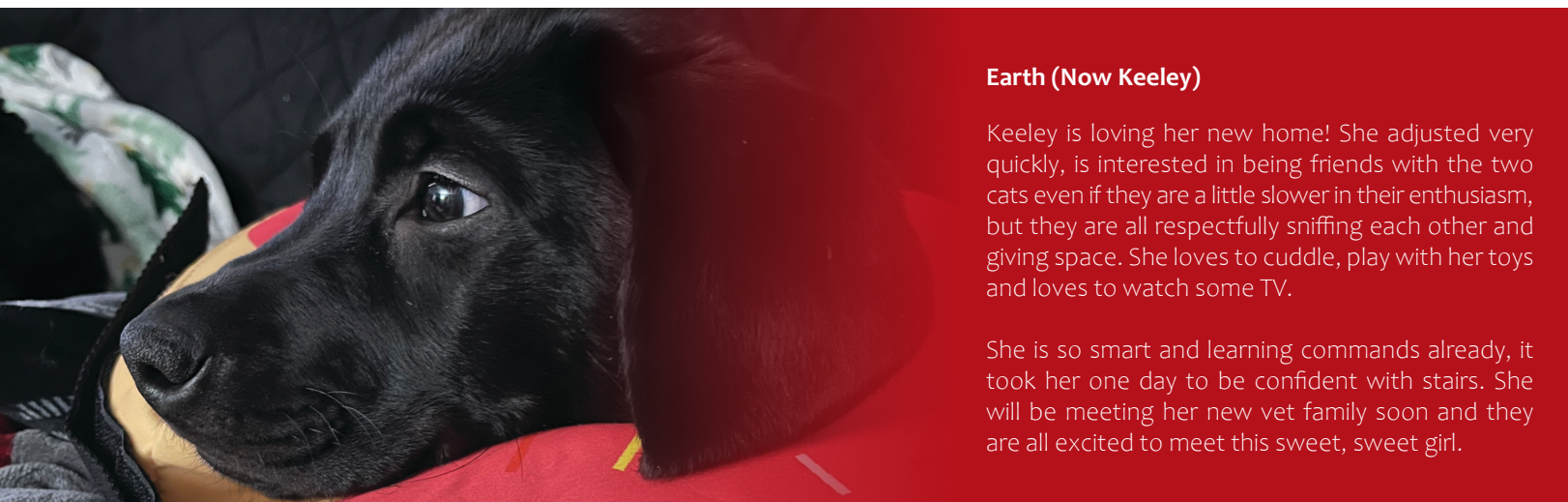




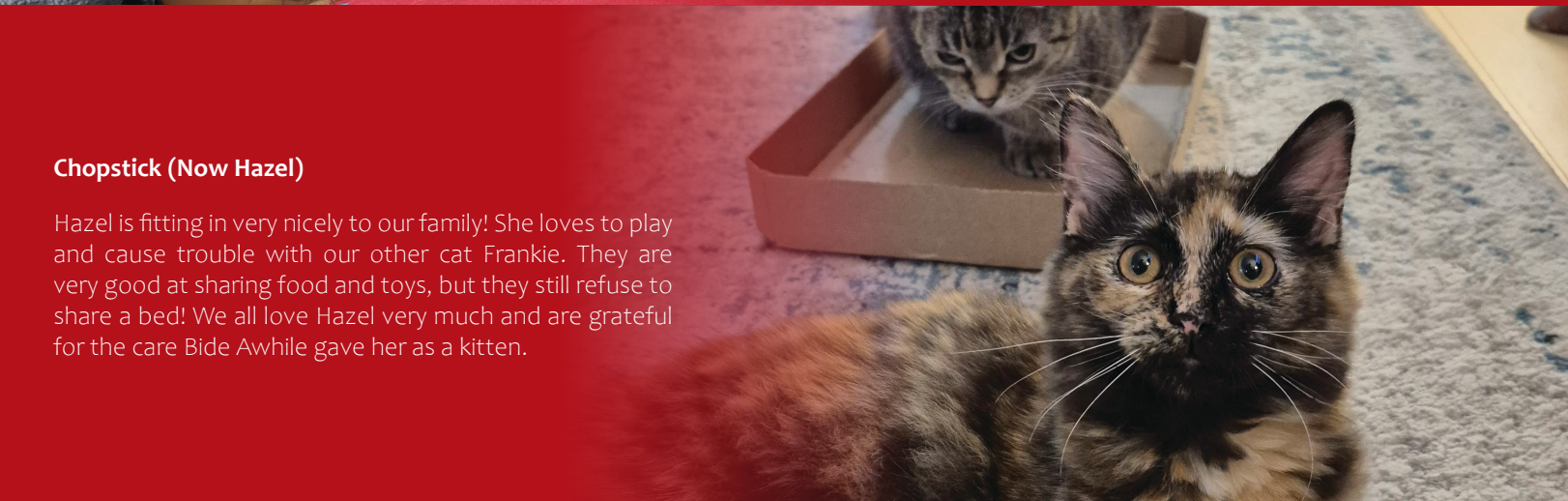
Adoption Updates 2025 Spring Newsletter



Earth (Now Keeley)

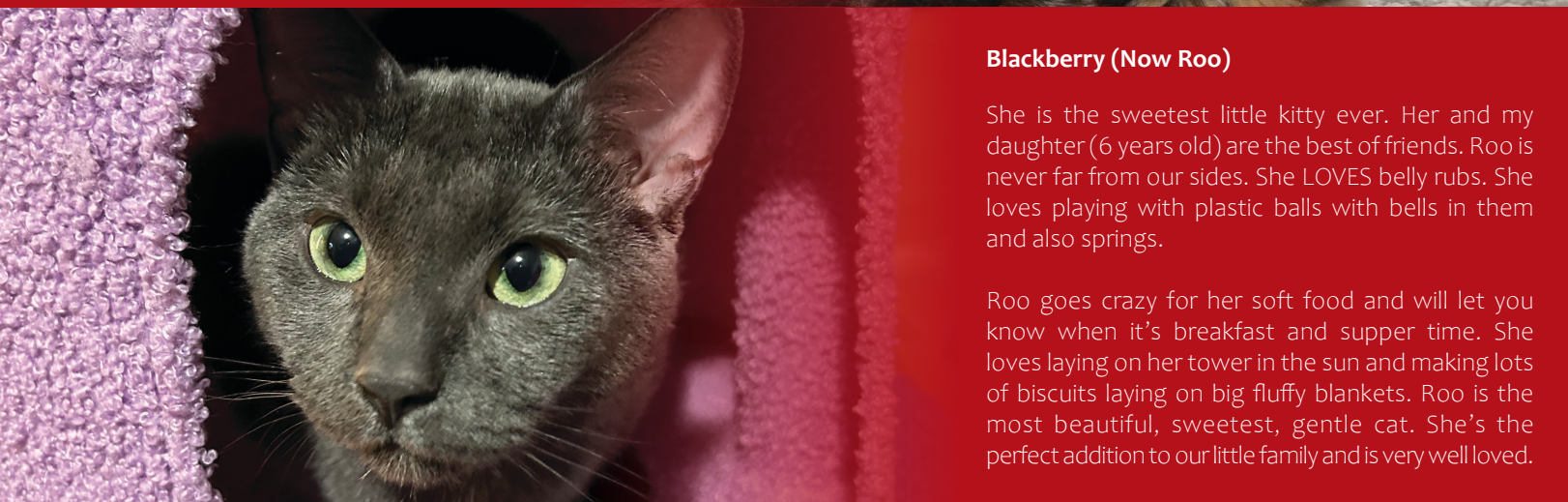

Mambo, Palliative Foster (Heart Disease)

Everyone Deserves a Home

Regardless of the age, health status, or breed, we believe that every animal is deserving of a loving home. This is why we created our Palliative Care and Long-Term Foster program for animals that struggle to find homes due to medical or behavioural reasons.

Through these permanent foster placements, animals involved in the program are still able to enjoy a high quality of life and get to experience the love of a home. Fosters are only required to cover the cost of food, litter, and love - all medical expenses are covered through Bide Awhile.

Currently, there are 17 cats in the program with a wide range of conditions such as chronic ear infections, behavioural challenges, and partial paralysis.
